## Revised Policy for Rush Orders By Bruce Stevenson

With the holiday season upon us, it is important to follow procedures and best practices. Please also pay close attention to the adjusted holiday ordering and Rush Order schedules that were provided to all Agencies. Here are the revised Rush Order procedures to help ensure your holiday requests are effectively managed:

### When to use Rush Orders

A rush order should be used to fulfill an unforeseen immediate customer need, occurring prior to your next anticipated delivery. If the rush order is within one day of the normal scheduled delivery, the rush order will be added to your regularly scheduled delivery day. Rush orders should not be used in place of the regular weekly delivery.

### How to Request a Rush Order

Agents submit a Requisition (REQ) for a Rush Order in the Agency Portal by selecting "Vendor/Broker Pick-Up" in the Mode of Delivery and adding "Rush Order" under Notes.

### Standards for Ordering

Rush Orders must meet the following criteria:

- ◆ **One rush order requisition per week;**
- ◆ Request must be for a minimum of five cases and a **maximum of 50 cases;**

- ◆ Must be an active item for sale (10, 70, or 79);
- ◆ Only items at \$299 or less per base retail bottle price (a list of items approved for Rush Orders will be provided);
- ◆ **You may not submit a rush order for displays, bags, gift sets, or new items;**
- ◆ **The rush order will stay in "review" status until delivery – DO NOT cancel the rush order.**



### Shipping of Products

- ◆ The entire process will be completed within a **24-48** hour window.
- ◆ Posting of Rush Order receipts will be done by DLC.
- ◆ Agents will receive notification of request approval from the trucking company, as well as the date of delivery. DLC will notify Agents if the request is denied.

### Exceptions Allowing for Vendor Pickups

- ◆ Items \$300 per bottle or greater will be permitted for vendor pickups (VPU). Please contact the product broker for all VPUs.

## Agency Holiday Information

### Deliveries:

- \* Agencies are required to schedule extra employees to unload and process larger deliveries.
- \* Please be flexible in terms of delivery day and time, and be prepared to unload/check in your orders as scheduled.
- \* Contact the trucking terminal manager with any questions about your delivery day or time.
- \* Please note if your delivery is delayed due to inclement weather or equipment problems, the trucking company is allowed to be up to an hour past the scheduled delivery time before they are considered late. The trucking company manager or driver will notify you of any such delays.
- \* Keep delivery areas clear of ice and snow.

### Bi-weekly Order/Delivery Agencies:

- \* Agencies with a bi-weekly delivery cycle that averages more than 100 cases per delivery may switch to weekly deliveries for between Thanksgiving Day and New Year's Day. Please contact your order clerk prior to November 4<sup>th</sup> to make arrangements.
- \* Weekly deliveries will begin the week of November 9<sup>th</sup>.
- \* Bi-weekly deliveries will resume effective with deliveries on January 4<sup>th</sup>.

### General Information:

- \* Voice-mail messages will be handled promptly and calls are only returned if requested. Please leave your agency number as part of your message.
- \* Agencies may also contact your ordering clerk by e-mail for ordering issues only (please do not leave messages in both voice and email as this will cause work to be duplicated).

## Drink Recipes

### Pumpkin Martini



- 1 part **Absolut Vanilla Vodka**
- 1 part Hiram Walker Pumpkin Spice Schnapps

**Directions:** Rim cocktail glass with cinnamon sugar. Combine ingredients in a shaker with ice. Shake vigorously and strain into prepared cocktail glass.

### Orchard Collins

- 2 oz. **Bourbon Barrel Gin from Watershed Distillery**
- 1.5 oz. Apple Cider
- .75 oz. fresh lemon juice
- .5 oz. ginger liqueur such as Domain De Canton
- 3 dashes Angostura Bitters

**Directions:** Shake, Strain into Collins glass over fresh ice, top with Angostura Bitters, Garnish with apple fan and crystallized ginger.



### Scarlet Fever

- **Buckeye Vodka**
- strawberry mix
- jalapeno juice

**Directions:** Mix ingredients and garnish with a sugar rim and a lime or jalapeno slice.



### Urban Assault

- **Buckeye Vodka**
- orange juice topped with Red Bull.

### Sweet Victory

- banana liqueur,
- peach schnapps and a splash of orange juice.
