

I am a real estate Salesperson in a state that DOES NOT have a reciprocal agreement with Ohio. How can I obtain an Ohio real estate salesperson's license?

Qualifications for an Ohio Salesperson's License:

1. Applicant must take four pre-licensure courses in a **classroom** setting at an institution of higher education:
 - Ohio Real Estate Law (40 hours)
 - Real Estate Principles & Practices (40 hours)
 - Real Estate Appraisal (20 hours)
 - Real Estate Finance (20 hours)
2. Be sponsored by an Ohio licensed broker

An applicant for an Ohio salesperson's license should submit:

1. A [Salesperson Examination Application](#) with \$60.00 fee.
2. A [Consent to Service of Process](#) form.
3. Proof of completion of the Ohio pre-licensure courses.

When the Division receives a complete application, the applicant's information will be sent to the testing vendor. The testing vendor will process the information and send a Candidate Information Bulletin with instructions on scheduling the test.

The applicant must pass both the State and National portions of the Ohio Real Estate Salesperson exam in order for a license to be issued. Passing score: 70
